

Environmental Survey – Derby - Urgent

An experienced person is sought to volunteer to conduct an environmental survey of Point Torment, Derby. A mining company, Rey Resources, is looking to become a thermal coal exporter in the Kimberley region, in a plan that would see an expansion of Derby port.

The Northern Development Taskforce report of 2008 states: "...King Sound is an area of very high risk for the navigation of large LNG & Condensate vessels. In addition there would almost certainly be significant delays that could not be built into forecast schedules. For these reasons Point Torment and all other sites in King Sound have been discarded as a likely LNG port for the purpose of this study."

The Wilderness Society has previously warned that WA Premier Colin Barnett's push for a major expansion of Derby port in the Kimberley is another ad hoc and dangerous step towards industrialising one of the world's last large great unspoiled areas.
