

## **Standard Terms & Conditions for Competitions**

1. Information on how to enter and prize details forms part of these conditions of entry.
2. Entry is open to residents of Australia only. Employees of the Wilderness Society and their immediate families are ineligible to enter. Entry is only valid if all compulsory details on the Entry Form are completed. Limit one prize in total.
3. Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. All entries become the property of the Promoter – The Wilderness Society Inc. The Wilderness Society reserves the right to use the content of winning and runners-up entries for the purpose of future promotions.
5. The Promoter is The Wilderness Society of 57E Brisbane Street, Hobart, TAS 7000.
6. The Wilderness Society hosts the competition and selects the winner, World Expeditions provides the prize and is responsible for providing the prize.
7. The Wilderness Society accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to prizes in transit. The Wilderness Society makes no representations or warranties as to the quality/suitability of any of the goods/services offered as prizes. To the extent permitted by law, the Wilderness Society is not liable for any loss suffered or sustained, to person or property and including, but not limited to, consequential (including economic) loss by reason of any act or omission, deliberate or negligent, by the Wilderness Society, or its agents, in connection with the arrangement for supply, or the supply, of any goods or services by any person to the prize winner.
