

## Sandcastles for Sanctuaries Competition

Thank you for entering a team in the first ever 'Sandcastles for Sanctuaries' event at Scarborough Beach! You're probably wondering what is going to happen on the day, and how you can prepare yourself a winning team – so we've got some suggestions...

### Guidelines

- (1) There are a maximum of five participants per team, of any age.
- (2) Teams are required to bring their own equipment – buckets, trowels, & tools for sculpting your creation (knives/ forks/ chopsticks)
- (3) Sandcastles are to be made entirely of sand/shells found within the amphitheatre, all other materials banned.
- (4) The event commences at 10.15am and concludes at 11.45am. There is a 1.5hr hour period to build the sandcastle.
- (5) Each team will be assigned a letter, to help spell out a sandcastle message 'Save Our Marine Life'. The sandcastle must be built in the shape of the assigned letter.
- (6) Judges are Karina Carvalho (ABC news), Renae Williams (TWS campaigner) & Jean-Marc Rivalland (2010 winner of 'Sculptures by the Sea').
- (7) The judges will base their decision on three key criteria:
  - (a) likeness to a marine theme – be it an animal, plant or feature of the marine environment (creativity & imagination)
  - (b) letter clarity
  - (c) form and final presentation
- (8) The judges' decision is both artistically subjective and final, and no debate will be entered into.
- (9) Prizes cannot be exchanged, substituted or redeemed for cash value.
- (10) Adult participants agree that photos taken during the event are available to The Wilderness Society and Save Our Marine Life for promotional purposes there after.
